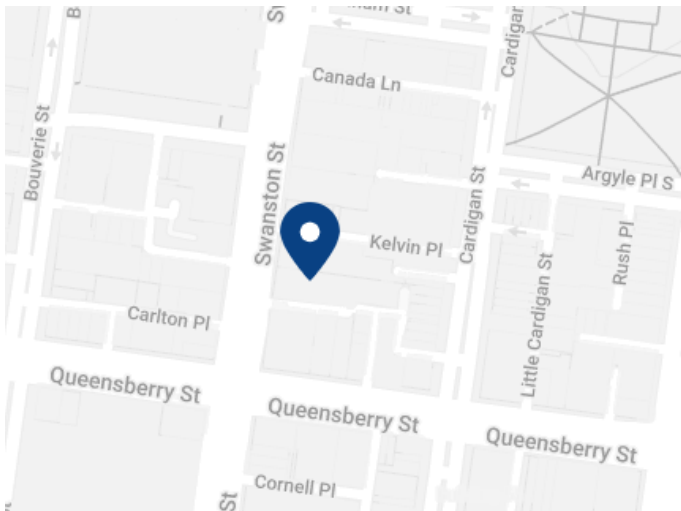

Getting here:

Train or tram: Take the train to Melbourne Central Station. Catch a tram north three stops along Swanston Street to Lincoln Square (tram stop 3). Walk 100m metres south (away from The University of Melbourne) to 550 Swanston Street

Parking: There is two hour metered parking on Swanston Street and four hour metered parking in Lincoln Square and Bouverie Street. There is a public car park on the corner of Grattan and Cardigan Streets in Carlton which is only a short walk from the Melbourne Hearing Care Clinic
